The General Accounting Office has reviewed certain activities of the Government of the Virgin Islands of the United States for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1961, pursuant to the Budget and Accounting Act, 1921 (31 U. S. C. 53), and the Accounting and Auditing Act of 1950 (31 U. S. C. 67). In view of section 19 of the Revised Organic Act of the Virgin Islands (48 U. S. C. 1632), our review centered on the office and activities of the Government Comptroller of the Virgin Islands, since these are subject to review annually by the Comptroller General of the United States. In addition, we made reviews of selected activities of the Government of the Virgin Islands. During the fiscal year 1961 the Government Comptroller issued 18 audit reports which disclosed continued serious weaknesses in the insular governments financial and accounting controls. Responses by operating officials evidenced general agreement with the need to strengthen such controls. Late in fiscal year 1960 the Office of the Government Comptroller had suspended its practice of requesting the views of the departments audited, through...
